"Percussion 2.0"

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Alejandro Coello Calvo is a Spanish percussionist and composer who, at only 23 years of age, obtained the post of professor of percussion at the Franz Lisz College of Music in Weimar (Germany).

He has been invited by prestigious institutions in Asia, America and Europe, working as a musical performer, lecturer, master class teacher or jury member in competitions. Today, he is known for the multiplicity of musical genres he masters and his delicate way of interpreting, characteristics that have driven him to conquer the world of percussion both nationally and internationally.

His works have been premiered in renowned venues such as **Carnegie** Hall in New York and the Berliner Philharmonie. Amonast his most recent projects is the album "One minute later", a collaboration with Diego Barber, Eric Harland and Ben Williams, which has introduced him to the jazz scene. In 2019, he released his first album, "Percussion Theory" with original works, on Sunnyside Records (NYC) in collaboration with Simon Phillips, jazz guitarist Diego Barber and saxophonist Xabier Casal.

The **goal** of these courses and lectures is to transmit to the students the knowledge acquired by Alejandro in recent years both in German universities and orchestras as well as the more **experimental field of New York.** A very intrinsic look at the world of performance, but with external results perfectly adapted to today's audiences.

Aimed at both students and teachers, the concept of these courses will help the musical, psychological and interpersonal development of the participants.

Weekend course

(Friday to Sunday)

-3 sessions in the morning and 3 sessions in the afternoon. -Total = 18 hours.

- 3 sessions in the morning and 3 sessions in the afternoon.

**Intensive advanced course

(4 meetings of 5 days each. Monday to Friday or Wednesday to Sunday).

- 4 sessions in the morning and 4 sessions in the afternoon approximately.

-Total = approximately 130 hours.

-Number of students listening to the course: unlimited.

**The frequency of the Intensive Improvement meetings will be adaptable and flexible, depending on the contract agreed between the institution/students and the guest teacher (weekly, monthly, bimonthly, etc.).

**Maximum/minimum number of students: 15/10.



Full Week Course (Monday to Friday)

-Total = 30 hours.



Masterclass

-4 sessions in the morning and 3 sessions in the afternoon. -Total = 7 hours.

*The distribution of the hours in both one and two days will be determined together with the relevant organisation, and may be subject to change.

-Day 1: 4 sessions morning or afternoon -Day 2: 3 morning or afternoon sessions -Total = 7 hours.



This weekend course will be divided into two very distinct sessions. In the first, more theoretical, we will present different topics related to the world of interpretation, instruments, creativity and other topics open to debate that will prepare us for the afternoon session where we will immerse ourselves in the works brought by the students.

On the last day, and as a farewell, there will be the option of a small concert by both the students and the teacher.







Full Week Course

The full-week course will also be divided into two sessions (similar to the weekend course) with the difference that in this case, we will be interspersed with percussion ensemble work and ensemble technique sessions. Active students will also have more time to present and work on their individual works.

We will also have the option of a concert at the end of the course, including the ensemble works worked on during the week.

The **goal** of this masterclass is to motivate and increase the students' interest in the world of music and more specifically in percussion.

Technical and musical aspects will be worked on, paying special attention to percussion both as a soloist and as an ensemble.

• Contents:

- Talking with the students about the real situation of percussion. "What does it mean to be a percussionist?

- Acquiring a correct planning for learning new materials.
- -To carry out individual classes with soloist works.
- To strengthen the "performer-audience" relationship with real practice.



Intensive Advanced Course



This course is divided into 4 meetings of 5 days each. The goal is to work individually with the repertoire presented by each participant.

Given the duration of the course, there will be continuous monitoring of each of the students, helping them to improve their technical, musical, creative and interpretative skills at all times. On the other hand, collective theory classes will be offered to provide new ideas, thoughts and knowledge to the participants.

All students can attend any individual class during the course as a listener.

At the same time, a conference dedicated not only to percussion students but also to all musical performers will be offered. The goal will be to deal with and offer knowledge regarding the way of selling any musical product that is developed, paying special attention to both the form of study and prior preparation, generating optimal means that will subsequently facilitate the work when facing the reality of a musical market, increasingly competitive and complex.

It is considered to be a subject that is little addressed in conservatories and which is arousing more and more curiosity among musicians.

The approximate duration is 2 hours.





*The subjects of each of the programmes will depend on the instrumentation provided by the requesting organisation, giving the possibility of adapting each intensive course or subject to the needs that arise.

This will be discussed with the relevant institution.

** Timetables are approximate. They will be agreed with the center.

*All fees for any intensive course will be discussed with the requesting organisation on a case-by-case basis, offering a wide margin of flexibility in budgets, subject to agreement between all parties.
